That they will have access to The Bible and godly materials and ministry; know Christ as Lord and Savior; grow in faith in Christ.
- 2. Those Recently Released**
That they connect to the Body of Christ; trust the Lord to meet their needs; resist every temptation of the Enemy; seek to restore broken relationships.
- 3. Those Who Work In Corrections**
That they are born again; encouraged in their faith; are honorable in their conduct; protected from the hardships of their work.
- 4. Those Who Serve As Chaplains And Religious Volunteers**
That they continue to grow in their walk with the Lord; their family and church support their ministry; humbly submit to authorities at facilities where they serve; never compromise the gospel.
- 5. For Those Left Behind: Spouses, Children, Parents, Etc.**
For God's grace to deal with emotional challenges and hurts; that they find a place in a local church; have ever need met.
- 6. The Body of Christ**
To love the post-incarcerated and their families well; engage in prison or aftercare ministry through prayer, giving & serving.
- 7. For Victims**
That they would find healing and forgiveness; for them to find Christ in the midst of their suffering.
